

Rules

1. **All riders should wear an ASTM approved helmet with chinstrap attached while. Boots with a heel are recommended.**
2. Rider's and horse's ages are determined as of January 1st 2009.
3. Green horses are those in their 1st or 2nd year of training and be 8 yrs. old or under as of 1/1/09, that have not yet mastered a controlled canter/lope. **Green horses should be ridden by experienced riders only.**
4. Walk-Trot riders must be unable to safely canter/lope in a group. These classes are for inexperienced, beginner or physically limited riders only.
5. When cross-entering a horse in both rings you should sign up for one ring only and add the second ring classes the day of the show if time permits. Holds will be limited.
6. Championship and Reserves are given in 11 divisions honoring the versatility of the horse. Day-end Champions are named at the conclusion of each show.
7. **You must send a check with your entry to constitute a pre-entry. Entries without payment will be charged the post-entry fees.**
8. This show uses the NH 4-H Horse Show Rulebook as a guide. There is no dress code requirement other than boots with a heel and an ASTM helmet recommendation.
9. Entry fees will not be refunded except due to **bona fide injury to horse or rider.** Management reserves the right to determine eligibility.
10. Horses that kick **must** wear a red ribbon tied to the tail.
11. Any questions concerning rules, decisions of the judge or class schedule should be directed to the manager.
12. Management will split large classes: No more than 10 in a W/T class or 20 in an open.
